

A Bylaw of Sturgeon Lake Regional Park
to amend the Building Bylaw No. 1-2011.

The Board of Directors of the Sturgeon Lake Regional Park Authority, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enact as follows:

1. Part 5.(9) of Bylaw 1-2011 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in its place:


- (9) All permits issued under this section expire
- (a) six months from the date of issue if work is not commenced within a period, or
 - (b) if work is suspended for a period of six months, or
 - (c) if work is suspended for a period of longer than six months bt prior written agreement of the local authority or its authorized representative.
 - (d) one year from the date of issue if work is not completed, except that a permit may be renewed for one additional year upon written application to the local authority accompanied by a fee of \$100.00. A single time extension may be granted by the local authority if the construction as listed in the building permit has reached.

1. This bylaw shall come into effect on its approval by the Minister of Saskatchewan Government Relations.




