

NOTICE TO ALL CABIN OWNERS!



BEFORE YOU SELL YOUR CABIN

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

This year there have been a number of cabins sold in the park prior to or without notifying the Board. This creates a huge problem for everyone involved!

Although you own the cabin and have every right to sell, there are other issues that must be considered.

Are the current year taxes paid?

- 2. Do you have any outstanding issues with your lease/cabin or lot? No lots within the park are owned by cabin owners. Do you know the terms of your lease???
 - -There are <u>NO</u> 99 year leases and the lease is <u>not transferable</u> without the express consent of the Board.
- 4. Will there be a mortgage, bank, realtors and/or lawyers involved in the sale transaction?

Following these steps to selling your cabin and avoid having a sale fall through or penalties incurred:

- 1. Apply in writing to the Sturgeon Lake Regional Park Board for a clearance to sell your cabin, include the name and phone number of your realtor.
- 2. Upon clearance, list your cabin. Be sure to inform your realtor and buyer as to the terms of your current lease.
- 3. Pay all outstanding property taxes to the RM of Shellbrook
- 4. Inform the Park Board of sale details-banks and lawyers must contact the Sturgeon Lake Regional Park Board.
- 5. The buyer must apply to be accepted as lease holder by the Sturgeon Lake Regional Park Board before they can obtain a lease. If accepted as a new lease holder, your existing lease will be transferred (not a new lease starting from the date of purchase)
- 6. The current fee is \$100 for a lease transfer, however, should the above procedures not be followed, the fee is \$500.
