Effective 9:30 a.m. — May 27, 2026

Fire Ban Overview

A **full fire ban** is now in place due to elevated fire-risk conditions. This measure is implemented to protect public safety and reduce the risk of wildfire.

Prohibited Activities

The following activities and devices are **not permitted** during the fire ban:

- Fire pits
- Burn barrels
- Brush piles, debris, stubble, and grass burning
- Charcoal BBQs
- Fireworks

This restriction applies to all outdoor open-flame devices, regardless of fuel type.

Important Notices

- All previously issued burn permits are **void**.
- The fire ban remains in effect **until further notice**.
